## Watercolor Explosion Coasters

## Materials:

- Watercolor kit
- Paintbrushes
- Straws
- Water
- Watercolor paper

- Coaster backing
- Hair dryer
- Sharpies, pencils
- Scissors
- Waterproof Mod Podge

## **Instructions:**

Note - You will want to change out your water frequently. You will also want to start with your lighter colors first.

- 1. Wet your brush and create a blot of pigment on a page section with a significant amount of water. If desired, add additional colors to the blot. Continue to add water as you go.
- 2. Using your straw, blow the pigment around the page in droplets, being sure to rotate the angle and direction of the blowing.
- 3. Repeat steps 1 3 until you have covered the page in watercolor explosions. Take your time.
- 4. Use the hair dryer to help dry your paper faster if desired.
- 5. Find a section of the page you would like to be a coaster and trace a circle using the cork coaster bottom. Cut out the circle.
- 6. Optional: draw flowers or geometric patterns on the circle using the Sharpies.
- 7. Seal the top of the coaster with the water-resistant Mod Podge and let dry.
- 8. Glue watercolor explosions to the coaster cork with the mod podge.
