

PUMPKIN PIE GARLAND INSTRUCTIONS

You will need:

- 1 or 2 pieces of orange felt (8 x 10 preferred)
- Nautical rope
- Jute twine
- Scissors
- Ruler (recommended)
- Tape (recommended)
- White pompoms
- Wooden beads
- Bamboo forks
- Hot glue gun

1. Cut 4-6 felt triangles. They should measure about 5 inches long.



2. Cut the nautical rope to the length of the top of the felt pie slice. Tip: use clear tape and wrap it around the edges of the rope, then cut around it. This prevents the edges from fraying.

3. Use hot glue to secure the rope piece to the top of the felt pie slice.

4. Glue one pom-pom to the middle of the pie slice.

5. Repeat steps 2-4 until all pie slices have “crust” and “cream.”

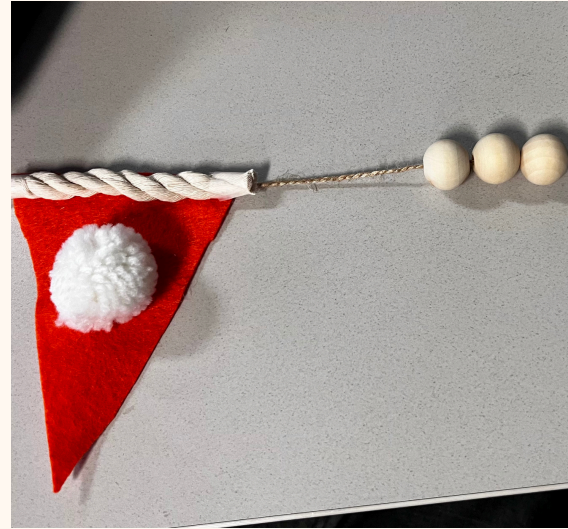
6. Lay your jute twine flat. Glue the back of one felt triangle (behind the rope) near one end of the twine.

7. String 3 wooden beads onto the twine.

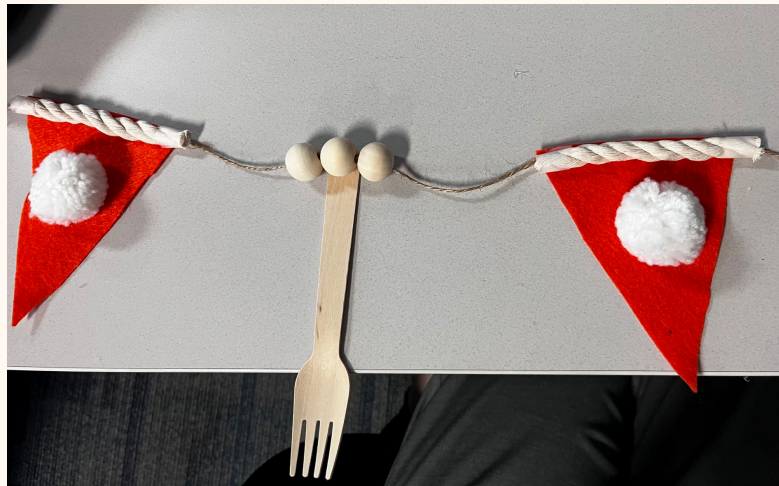

8. Repeat steps 6 and 7 until all of the desired felt triangles are glued onto the twine.

9. In each beaded “section,” glue a bamboo fork onto the back of the middle bead.

10. Hang your garland and enjoy!
