# HAPPY NEW YEAR FROM THE FRIENDS OF HTPL!



Throughout 2024, the Friends board has spent a lot of time defining who the Friends of HTPL are and our role in the library and the surrounding community.

The Friends are invested in the library's future. We raise money for programming, spread the word throughout our community, and have fun doing it!

Over the last year we've donated approximately \$10,000 to support children and adult programming at HTPL!
