

## Internet Use Policy

### Policy Statement

Internet access and computing resources are provided to all HTPL patrons in good standing. Non-residents may use computers and Internet for a \$1.00 fee per 30 minute session.

HTPL cannot be held responsible for the internet's content, quality or accuracy.

Computer stations must be used in a responsible manner, respecting the rights of others and taking care with the use of the equipment. Patrons are asked to be sensitive of others' values and beliefs.

### Regulations

1. Computer access requires a current HTPL card or a non-resident \$1.00 fee for each 30 minute session. Use your library card to check out a public computer pass at the circulation desk.
2. Computer access is for 30 minutes. Patrons may request additional time if no one is waiting.
3. Patrons are required to ask Staff before printing. The printing charge is \$0.10 per page for black and white copies and \$0.50 per page for color copies.
4. Children under age 13 require supervision by a parent or guardian and cannot be left unattended at a computer station.
5. Internet access may be unavailable at times due to technical difficulties.
