Join us and Master Gardener, Sue Keehn, for a workshop on successful container gardens. We'll learn about successful container combinations and make a small container garden to take home. Registration is limited and required.



Meditation for Beginners ~ Tuesday, May 1st at 7:00pm

In this class we will learn the basic tools for meditation. We will be using several methods to still the mind, including silent meditation, mantra meditation (using words or phrases that focus the mind), mala meditation (using meditation beads), visualization, and guided meditation.

Slow Flow Vinyasa Workshop ~ Saturday, May 12th at 1:00pm

A bit of alignment and a bit more flow. We'll move and breathe, taking time to pause and feel; observe and adjust. Mindful movement is coupled with breath, and longer holds in poses are complimented with active alignment cues. This class is suitable for students newer to yoga as well as experienced students interested in a lower intensity flow. Please wear loose, comfortable clothes and bring a mat or towel for yoga.

Mindful Movements Senior Seminar ~ Wednesday, May 23rd at 11:00am

There's so much movement we do throughout the day without being aware of it. Mindful movement refers to moving your body while placing your attention and focus on noticing and feeling what your body does throughout those movements. Sitting, standing, walking, bending, lifting. In mindful movement we are practicing being aware of our whole body. This class is appropriate for all levels of ability. Chairs will be provided for those who find it difficult to get up and down from the floor. Bring a mat or towel if you plan to do poses on the floor.

Local Author Alan Naldrett ~ Wednesday, May 23rd at 7:00pm

Alan Naldrett, a local author, jazz/blues musician, and historian, will be here for a discussion and book signing on his latest book about C. Harold Wills and his influence on the early history of the Ford Motor Company. Wills, who was Ford's right hand man, designed all the cars from Model A to T, developed automotive steel, and created the Ford logo. Naldrett has written over ten books as well as a number of columns in history magazines. His latest book is at the Henry Ford Museum and was in Michigan History Magazine.

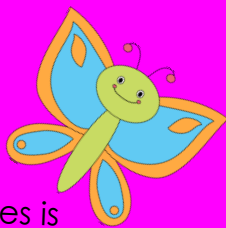

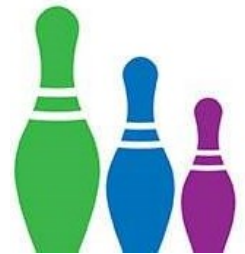
